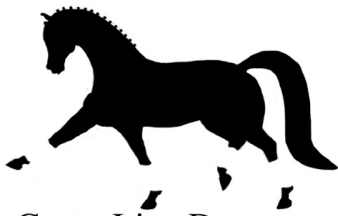

<p>Novice</p> <p>A horse and rider pair may compete as a novice for two years in a particular level before moving to Adult Am, JR/YR or Open.</p>		<p>Open Division</p>
<p>Open</p> <p>No restriction as to age or professional status.</p>		<p>Only scores gained at shows approved by USEF and USDF are accepted in this division.</p>
